Lupembe Primary School now has 823 pupils enrolled, made up of 398 boys and 425 girls. The children range from Standards 1 to 8.

There are 8 permanent classrooms at the school and the pupils are taught by a total of 10 teachers. The school's water sources are running tap water and a borehole in the school grounds, which is very close to the kitchen, and there are 10 pit latrine toilets on site which are shared equally between the boys and girls.

In addition to a woodlot, the school has a football pitch and a netball court for the children to use.
